There has been an increase in theft of number plates again so if possible use secure screws which can easily be purchased online so that they cannot be removed from your vehicle. Stolen plates are usually used in crime a short time after being taken.

If you are going away on holiday then ask friends or relatives to keep an eye on your property. Open and close curtains, lights on and off at different times, collect post etc.
